Welcome to Senior College Prizegiving for 2019.

At the start of 2019, we had much to celebrate with our top achieving students lifting Saint Kentigern College to the pinnacle of national academic achievement. We were the only school in New Zealand to have two students in the top 11 Secondary School Scholars. Two of our students also topped the Scholarship subjects of Statistics, and Design and Visual Communication, joining an elite group of 35 'Top in Subject' nationwide. At the same time, our Scholarship results improved from 34 subject Scholarships in 2017, to 82 in 2018, the best our students have achieved to date.

These important NZQA Scholarship exams will be sat by many of the students going across the stage tonight. We look forward to celebrating their successes in these, and their NCEA or IB examinations, at the start of 2020.

In the meantime, we have come tonight to celebrate the academic achievements of our top academics throughout 2019, along with those who have served and led with distinction.

If it was not for our talented and dedicated staff, teaching, guiding and encouraging our students, these impressive achievements would not be possible. Given the New Zealand teacher shortage, we are so very fortunate to have a team of passionate, highly qualified teachers who not only give of their best in the classroom, but also in our co-curricular activities as coaches, mentors and role models to our young men and women.

Thank you to the Senior College staff leaving us this year, for the wonderful contribution you have made, particularly to long serving staff for your years of dedicated service - Mrs Sandra Shaw for 17 years, Mrs Cheryl Hardie 16 years, Mrs Sasha Howard and Mr Chris Martin for 10 years and Music Administrator Mrs Anne Clifford for 12 years of service.
