Scholarships are available at Saint Kentigern College for boys and girls who wish to enter from Year 9 in 2022.

Scholarship Applications for 2022 close Monday 5 April 2021

All Scholarship candidates must sit a test or an assessment on Friday 16 April 2021

- **Future Me Scholarships.** Future Me scholarships are available for students who demonstrate outstanding achievement and attitude in the areas of academics, sport, performing and visual art.
- **Boarding Scholarships.** Scholarships are available for talented students who need to board at Bruce House to take advantage of the opportunities offered at Saint Kentigern College. The amount of the fee reduction is at the discretion of the Principal.
- **Old Collegians Scholarship.** This is the gift of the Saint Kentigern Old Collegians Association to celebrate the 50th Jubilee of the College. The recipient must be the child of an Old Collegian or have a strong family connection to an Old Collegian. The Old Collegians Jubilee Scholarship covers 33.3% of the tuition fees. There is only one Old Collegian Jubilee Scholarship awarded each year.

Scholarships are awarded from the beginning of Year 9 and are for the duration of the student's schooling and are subject to annual review. All candidates are required to submit a CV with their application, sit examinations, and attend an interview. Continuation is dependent on the student's academic performance, attitude and contribution to the overall life of the College.

Scholarships are awarded on merit to those students who demonstrate excellence in any area, who uphold the Saint Kentigern values, and demonstrate an outstanding attitude with a clear vision of their "Future Me" and the contribution they will make to the world.
