HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

The Saint Kentigern Trust Board is committed to providing a workplace that enables all work activities to be carried out safely. We will take all reasonably practicable steps to eliminate or minimise risks to the health, safety and welfare of workers (contractors, sub-contractors, labour hire employees, apprentice etc), students, visitors and anyone else who may be affected by our operations.

We are committed to ensuring we comply with the Health and Safety At Work Act, 2015 (the Act). We will also comply with any other relevant legislation, Codes of Practice, Australian/New Zealand standards, so far as reasonably practicable.

We will provide policies and procedures that set out safe practices for workers to follow, to ensure compliance with the Act and appropriate mechanisms for engagement. We will establish annual OHS objectives and targets, which we will review and monitor.


The Saint Kentigern Trust Board will:

- Provide and maintain a healthy and safe work environment through the implementation of safe work practices, safe systems of work and the provision of safe plant and equipment; and
- Ensure that workplaces under the control of The Saint Kentigern Trust Board are safe, without risks to health; and
- Engage with workers in order to maintain effective and co-operative relationships between the Saint Kentigern Trust Board and its workers and with other duty holders on health and safety matters in the workplace; and
- Review and monitor the effectiveness of the safety measures taken.

The Saint Kentigern Trust Board are committed to providing safe and healthy working environments for its workers and students including:

- Providing relevant, up-to-date health and safety information to all workers on matters such as workplace safety and their responsibilities; and
- Providing expert assistance in health and safety matters where required; and
- Providing instruction and/or training in work processes, where appropriate; and
- Developing and implementing strategies which include workplace assessment, hazard identification and appropriate action to eliminate or minimise hazards; and
- Gathering and reviewing appropriate information and reporting of this information.
